Bali Style Silver Bracelet | Adventurous Intermediate

Class fee: \$50, materials are extra

This quadruple-loop motif was inspired by the beautiful metalwork of the Balinese people. You'll make enough links for your desired length bracelet, then make your own jump rings to attach the links. Finally, you'll make a simple hook & eye clasp to finish the bracelet.



Materials for Bali Style Silver Bracelet

- 20 gauge wire, approx. 4 ft.
- 28 gauge wire, approx. 6 ft.
- 4mm jump rings, approx. 50
- Size 11/0 seed beads to match the wire or another color as desired,

OR 2mm gemstones or crystals (approx. 50) and 3mm gemstones or crystals (approx. 26)

Learn to make five different variations on an elegant chain design that you can adapt for use in your own projects.



Materials for Make Your Own Beaded Chains

- 20 gauge wire, approx. 20 ft.
- 28 gauge wire, approx. 1.5 ft.
- 10 beads: 4mm or 6mm

The tree of life is an iconic symbol in many cultures. In this class you'll learn to create a graceful tree silhouetted against a scenic stone background.

Materials for Tree of Life Bezel

- 1 cabochon, at least 30mm x 40mm
- 18 gauge wire, approx. 8 inches
- 28 gauge wire, approx. 6 ft.

Thursday through Saturday AFTERNOON Classes

4 – 6 pm | Thursday, October 19 Quick & Easy Wire Bezel | Beginner

Class fee: \$30, materials are extra

Here is a unique and easy way to attractively bezel cabochons without the need for soldering or torches. This is perfect for those beautiful but undrilled stones you didn't need but couldn't resist, and works especially well with small cabochons.

Materials for Quick & Easy Wire Bezel

- 1 small cabochon, no larger than 25mm to 35mm (see note below)
- 18 gauge wire, approx. 1 ft.
- 28 gauge wire, approx. 2 ft.
- Size 11/0 or 15/0 seed beads

3 - 6 pm | Friday, October 20 Southwestern "No Loom" Earrings |

Adventurous Beginner

These earrings were inspired by the amazing beadwork of various southwestern Native American Tribes. No loom required!

Materials for Southwestern "No Loom" Earrings

- 18 gauge wire, approx. 1 ft
- 20 gauge wire or 2 earwires
- 24 gauge wire, approx. 1 ft.



- 28 gauge wire, approx. 3 ft Size 11/0 seed beads in 5 colors
- 10 spear-paddle style headpins (available from Melody)

Learn to make simple and decorative clasps, ear wires, headpins and bead wraps to use in your own creations.

Materials for Make Your Own Findings

20 gauge wire, approx. 12 ft.





Sunday Afternoon Class

1 – 5 pm | Sunday, October 22 Bezeled Stone Pendant | Intermediate Class Fee: \$50, materials are extra

Start with a simple bezeling technique around a stone or cabochon and learn how to embellish it with lavish bands of color for an elegant and unique effect.



Materials for Bezeled Stone Pendant

- 1 cabochon, no larger than 18mm x 25mm
- 18 gauge wire, approx. 1 ft
- 24 gauge wire, approx. 1 ft
 - 28 gauge wire, approx. 10 ft.
- Size 15/0 seed beads, 3 grams
- Size 11/0 seed beads, 2 grams in each of 5 to 7 colors.
