Rosary Center **PUTTING IT TOGETHER** Beads are strung or linked together according to the diagram. If using beading wire, the longer length of wire is crimped to the two top corners of the rosary center, with the shorter length crimped at the bottom of the rosary center and to the crucifix. Crucifix A typical pattern separates each Hail Mary bead with two or three seed beads, and the Our Father beads with three or four beads to help set them apart. If using chain and bead links, a short length of chain is often

used on either side of the Our Father beads.

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
